

Parade Terms & Conditions for Isle of Wight Pride Saturday 20th July 2024

1. All Parade participants **must** meet in their respective groups at Ryde School, Lower Field and Car Park, Queen's Road, Ryde, PO33 3BG for registration between **8:45AM and 9.45AM on Saturday 20th July 2024.**
2. **PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU HAVE ASSIGNED ONE MARSHAL PER EVERY 10 PARADE PARTICIPANTS IN YOUR PARTY. ALL MARSHALS MUST ATTEND AN ON-SITE BRIEFING, AT RYDE SCHOOL, AT 10AM ON THE DAY OF THE PARADE.**
3. Participants **must not** litter the Ryde School site or the Parade route in any way.
4. Pets are **not allowed** on the Ryde School site
5. Parade participants **must, at all times, keep to their allocated position within the Parade, throughout the route.**
6. Parade participants **must** obey directions of the Parade Director, stewards, marshals and/or Police at all times.
7. Participants **must not** encroach onto pavements, harass, or obstruct members of the public.
8. Participants **must** keep to one half of the public highway - in the agreed directional flow of traffic at all times and as directed.
9. For health and safety purposes, **alcohol consumption is strictly prohibited** on the Ryde school site or along the Parade route, at any time, by any Parade participant. Please note that the Ryde School site is strictly **NO SMOKING.**
10. Participants **must** provide details of all materials including banners and materials to be used as part of the Parade. We want to make sure this event is as environmentally friendly as possible. Please consider this when designing your costumes/float and recycle/upcycle where possible. If using glitter, it **must** be of a biodegradable type.
11. Any materials or displays used as part of the Parade **must**, in the opinion of the organisers, be appropriate for public display.
12. The organisers reserve the right to reject any Parade application where they consider the organisation and/or the goods/services offered by it are not supportive of the aims and objectives of Isle of Wight Pride.
13. Cancellation **must** be made by email to **parade@iwpride.org** as soon as possible but at least 10 days prior to the event, giving a reason for the cancellation. Refunds of any donations made will only be given at the discretion of the Isle of Wight Pride Trustees.

14. In the unlikely event that the event is cancelled, postponed, or rescheduled, no refunds of donations will be given. The organisers will not be liable for any other expenses arising from event cancellation, postponement, or rescheduling.

15. Unless otherwise agreed in writing prior to the Parade, no generators or engines, other than standard motor vehicles, are permitted on the Parade route.

16. Although the organisers hold public liability insurance, to the extent permitted by law, no responsibility or liability is accepted for loss, howsoever caused, including any loss arising from: loss of earnings, theft, loss or damage to any property, power failure, bad weather, or event cancellation. You **must** provide your own Public Liability Insurance and produce a copy if demanded by the organisers. The organisers maintain the right to recover from you any costs incurred by them should you be legally liable for any claim or part of a claim arising from your participation in the Parade.

17. It is your sole responsibility to ensure that the materials you use for any display are fit for the purpose of the Parade and are safe and kept secure - so as not to pose a risk of injury to any participant or member of the public. Displays **must be checked** at regular intervals, throughout the Parade route, to ensure they remain safe and secure.

18. Organisations **must** take responsibility for the health and safety of their participating members or staff and abide by all applicable regulations and codes of practice. Every effort should be made to safeguard against "damage to" or "theft of" articles left in their charge.

19. The organisers reserve the right to reject or cancel any application for this and other events from any participant failing to comply with any of the aforementioned conditions or with any reasonable request made by the organisers or their staff, either orally or in writing.

20. Any participant may be required to leave the Parade, immediately, along any point of the route if they fail to comply with the terms and conditions set out in this agreement.
