INTRODUCTION

Isle of Wight Pride has established itself as a valued and expected annual event and is committed to being part of the calendar of community events on the Island. We see the charity as having long-term sustainability by being embedded into the community of the Isle of Wight.

Our aim is to use the annual event to champion the importance of equality and diversity by highlighting the advances that have been made for the LGBTQIA+ community in the UK and around the world, whilst also raising awareness of the prejudice and danger that many still face. We know that this event has allowed people who left the Isle of Wight, feeling that they did not belong, to return home with confidence that they can be themselves. Isle of Wight Pride has made a change for the better on the Isle of Wight.

Isle of Wight Pride is open for all to enjoy who share our vision for a world in which people can be their authentic selves with no fear of censure, judgement, inequality, or abuse.



BACKGROUND

In 2017, Isle of Wight Pride was established as a charity and staged the island's first annual LGBTQIA+ festival in Ryde with a Pride parade and activities focused on the beach and Eastern Gardens for approximately 5,000 people. The charity was formed on the principles of promoting equality and diversity for the public benefit, the elimination of discrimination on the grounds of sexual orientation and gender identity, raising awareness to the public about the issues and difficulties affecting the lives of LGBTQIA+ people, cultivating a sentiment in favour of equality and diversity and staging an annual LGBTQIA+ festival.

In 2018, following the tremendous success of our first year, we hosted UK Pride, and a larger event was held for approximately 12,000 people on Ryde Esplanade. The following year Isle of Wight Pride staged another fantastic community event and parade and was making plans for 2020 when COVID-19 put a stop to events.

For the last two years, Isle of Wight Pride has returned with its LGBTQIA+ festival in Ryde. Each year played host to a three-day event starting on the Friday, the Pride Parade and Community Village on the Saturday and concluding with some fantastic local entertainment on the Sunday.

The unique location, being the only beach Pride in the UK, along with the appeal of the island brings visitors from all over the country.
